What is this traineeship about?

RII20920 Certificate II in Drilling Operations is designed for employees such as assistant drillers who undertake a prescribed range of functions involving known routines and procedures.

To obtain this qualification you will require:

- 8 core units of competency
- 4 elective units (1 elective may be substituted from a relevant endorsed Training Package)

The selection of typical traineeship units is presented below.

Core Units – 8 units required

BSBWOR203	Work effectively with others
RIICOM201E	Communicate in the workplace
RIIENV201E	Identify and assess environmental and heritage concerns
RIINHB201E	Load, secure and unload drilling equipment and materials
RIINHB202E	Set up and pack up drill sites
RIINHB203E	Support drilling processes
RIIRIS201E	Conduct local risk control
RIIWHS201E	Work safely and follow WHS policies and procedures

Electives – 4 units required

To be selected and agreed by RTO, employer and trainee at time of enrolment.

How is the course delivered?

This course is available by Australian Training Management as a registered traineeship qualification enrolled by an employer only. Participants who are employed either full-time or part-time for a minimum of 20 hours per week are eligible for this traineeship.

Training and assessment will be a combination of on-site and online training. Assessment decisions can be appealed.

The average course duration for **RII20920 Certificate II in Drilling Operations** is 12 months.
